TLI30207 Certificate III in Transport and Logistics (Road Transport)

The qualification TLI30207 Certificate III in Transport and Logistics (Road Transport) is designed for those working within the transport and logistics industry. Participants are generally transport operators, couriers, bus drivers or other heavy vehicle drivers. The program is typically completed during working operations and in practical environments.

This qualification is typically completed over a two year period under the structure of a workplace traineeship. At Benchmark OHS Consulting, we believe the greatest environment for a participant to learn is their own work environment. As such, we provide on-the-job training and assessment for participants. Our trainer/assessors generally travel with a driver in the cab of the vehicle to conduct assessment activities and train skills gaps.

Qualification Structure

The qualification TLI30207 Certificate III in Transport and Logistics (Road Transport) encompasses units of competency from certificate levels one through to three. A total of twenty one (21) units of competency are required to be completed in order to achieve the qualification. Seven (7) of these units are to be selected from the Certificate I level, with a further seven (7) from Certificate II and the remaining seven (7) from Certificate III.

The Transport and Logistics Training Package has designated streams that each unit of competency fits into. These streams are based on the skills and tasks required to be assessed. The streams applicable to this qualification are as follows:

- Handling Stock/Cargo
- Equipment Checking and Maintenance
- Driving Vehicles
- Load Handling
- Documentation and Calculations
- Occupational Health and Safety
- Teamwork
- Route Planning and Navigation
- Customer Service
- Quality
- Computers and Technology
- Resource Management
- Training
- Assessment

- Security
- Financial Management
- Records
- Environment

Certificate I Units of Competency

The following is a sample selection of units of competency from Certificate I for the qualification TLI30207 Certificate III in Transport and Logistics (Road Transport):

TLIA107C Secure Cargo

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to secure cargo including preparing to secure cargo/containers; lashing and unlash cargo; protecting cargo from weather; and packing and unpacking cargo. It may apply in cargo securing contexts in the stevedoring, transport, distribution and allied industries.

TLIC107C Drive Vehicle

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to drive commercial light vehicles and cars safely, including the systematic, safe and efficient control of all vehicle functions; monitoring of traffic and road conditions; management of vehicle condition, and performance and effective management of hazardous situations. Assessment of this unit will usually be undertaken within a licensing examination conducted by, or under the authority of, the relevant State/Territory Road Traffic Authority.

TLID107C Shift Materials Safely Using Manual Handling Methods

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to shift loads using manual handling methods, including assessing the risks associated with relocating the load; planning the relocation process; and carrying out the relocation in accordance with the plan.

TLIE307C Participate in Basic Workplace Communication

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to participate effectively in basic workplace communication including communicating information about routine tasks, processes, events or skills; participating in group discussions to achieve appropriate work outcomes; and representing views of a group to others.

TLIF107C Follow Occupational Health and Safety Procedures

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to follow and apply OHS procedures when carrying out work activities, including identifying and following workplace procedures for hazard identification and risk control; contributing to arrangements for the management of occupational health and safety records; and completing occupational health and safety records.

TLIG107C Work Effectively With Others

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to work effectively with others in a workplace including contributing to determination of appropriate work roles; contributing to the planning of activities; and working with others to complete the activities.

TLII207D Apply Customer Service Skills

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to apply routine customer service skills to relevant workplace operations including dealing with customer inquiries; monitoring customer satisfaction; and taking appropriate action to satisfy customer needs.

Certificate II Units of Competency

The following is a sample selection of units of competency from Certificate II for the qualification TLI30207 Certificate III in Transport and Logistics (Road Transport):

TLIB407C Carry Out Vehicle Inspection

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to carry out an inspection of a commercial vehicle, including action to implement the vehicle manufacturer's specifications for routine checks, to clean the vehicle and to ensure that all specified safety requirements are met and that the vehicle is operational to the requirements of both the workplace and the relevant State/Territory roads and traffic authority.

TLI107C Drive Medium Rigid Vehicle

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to drive a medium rigid vehicle safely including systematic and efficient control of all vehicle functions; monitoring of traffic and road conditions; management of vehicle condition; and performance and effective management of hazardous situations. Assessment of this unit will usually be undertaken within a licensing examination conducted by, or under the authority of, the relevant State/Territory Road Traffic Authority.

TLID407CB Load and Unload Goods/Cargo

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to load and unload goods and cargo, including loading and unloading goods; securing and protecting the load; and completing all required documentation.

TLIE707B A Use Communication Systems

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to use communication systems including operating a communication system effectively; using appropriate communication protocols when using a system; communicating with a base; identifying faulty operation of communications equipment and taking appropriate action.

TLIF1007C Apply Fatigue Management Strategies

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to apply fatigue management strategies, including identifying and acting upon signs of fatigue; and implementing appropriate strategies to minimise fatigue during work activities.

SSBCMN209A Meet Customer Needs and Expectations

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to understand, clarify and meet customer needs and expectations in a single encounter or multiple encounters, on a one-to-one basis with a customer.

TLIU707B Care for the Environment

This unit involves the skills and knowledge required to care for the environment when operating and maintaining equipment and/or vehicles including minimising the effects of pollution during operations; minimising the effects of pollution during maintenance; and transporting and handling environmentally hazardous materials safely and in accordance with environmental protection regulations and guidelines.
